

- C. **Text:** Exodus 2:21-25

God is working in the life of Moses and in the lives of the enslaved Hebrews. Moses is getting married and starting a family (2:21-22). The king from whom Moses has fled died (2:23a). But despite the change in leadership the Hebrews remained in bondage and cried out to God (2:23b). God heard their groaning, remembered His covenant with them, and acknowledged them (2:24-25). Unknown to everyone was that God was working to prepare Moses to lead them out of bondage and into the Promised Land!

HOW TO DISCOVER WHERE GOD IS AT WORK AROUND YOU

Experiencing God Reality #1: God is always at work around you.



I. ACKNOWLEDGE THAT GOD IS AT WORK AROUND YOU

God was working in your life before you were conceived and continues through your life.

“Before I formed you in the womb I knew you; Before you were born I sanctified you; I ordained you a prophet to the nations.”
Jeremiah 1:5

II. ACCEPT THAT GOD WANTS TO WORK THROUGH YOU

“10 Come now, therefore, and I will send you to Pharaoh that you may bring My people, the children of Israel, out of Egypt.”

Moses' Gave Six Excuses For Not Working With God:

- Guilt: Who am I to appear before Pharaoh? (3:11a).
- Insecurity: Who am I to lead the people? (3:11b).
- No Authority: Who shall I say is sending me? (3:13).
- Failure: What if they don't believe me? (4:1).
- Lack of Ability: I am not a very good speaker (4:10).
- Comfort: Lord, please send someone else (4:13).
